SHE TAKES ACTION IN DEFENCE OF LIFE

In 1999, Revd Housset, Archbishop of Montauban asked Geneviève to revive the Catholic Families Association in the department of Tarn-et-Garonne, in France at a time when the PACS was being implemented.

In 2008, on request of Revd Ginoux, the new Archbishop of Montauban, Geneviève pursued a formation organised by Revd d'Ornellas's working group in preparation of the law on bioethics.

Based in Paris since 2009, she took part in all of the debates relating to this law on bioethics being the person responsible for the bioethics division of the CNAFC.

She was heard by the SICARD Mission in September 2012.

PUBLICATIONS

With a team of medical and legal practitioners, Geneviève Veret has produced :

- A series of factsheets addressed to parliamentarians, on all the different bioethics points that need amending by the Parliament : Medically Assisted Reproduction, Embryo Research, Pre-implantation Diagnosis (PID), Prenatal Diagnosis (PND), Organ Donation, Gestational Surrogacy, Donation of Gametes, Umbilical Cord Blood, End of Life.
