Elected MP for the IX Constituency (Friuli-Venezia Giulia) on March 5, 2013, member of the Parliamentary Group "Democrazia solidade-Centro Democratico", head of the Group DES-CD in the Commission I (Constitutional Affairs) and in the Bicameral Commission for regional affairs.

### A LEADER IN DEFENCE OF LIFE

He was previously a member of the Superior Council of Health, Board Member the Italian Society of Neurology and Chairman of the Italian Association of Sleep Medicine.

He was also President of the International Federation of Catholic Medical Associations, member of the Pontifical Council for Health Pastoral Care and the Executive Board of "Scienza e Vita".

He led the fight to save the life of Eluana Englaro. Knight of the Order of St. Gregory the Great; he was awarded the medal of the Good Samaritan. He was elected President of "Movimento per la Vita Italiano" on March 21, 2015.
